Duration

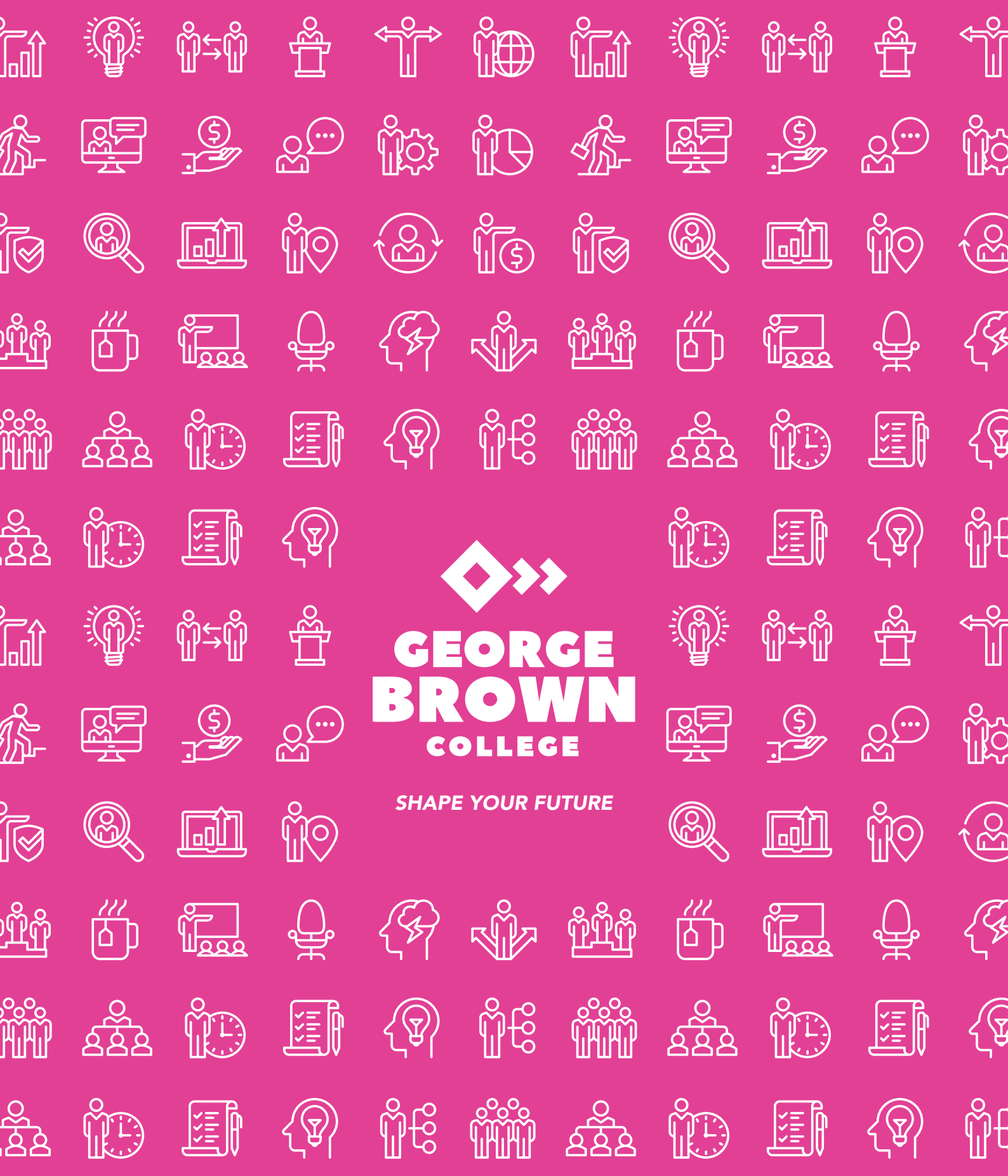
Internship lengths can vary depending on candidates background and experience, but usually run from 10 weeks to 3 months.
